Mr. Lloyd Kenneth Beck, 68, of Salisbury passed away Sunday, December 10, 2017 at his home.

Born May 6, 1949 in Orlando, FL, and was the son of the late Lloyd James Beck and Emie Lee Bryant Beck.

He was educated in the North Rowan schools and graduated from North Rowan High School in 1967. While at North Rowan High School he set the state record for the most receptions in one game, which he held for 38 years. Mr. Beck attended Gardner Webb College.

Mr. Beck was a veteran of the US Marine Corps First Marine Division and served in the Vietnam War.

He was a District Manager for I. H. Services before retiring due to a disability.

Mr. Beck was a life member of Mt. Tabor United Methodist Church where he served on the Pastor Parrish Committee and served as a Trustee. He was also a life member of the American Legion.

Interment will follow at the VA National Cemetery with Military Graveside Rites conducted by the US Marine Corps and Rowan County Veterans Honor Guard.
