Mr. Lloyd "Jay" Beck, 91, of Salisbury, NC passed away Monday, October 7, 2013 at Genesis Eldercare of Salisbury.

Born December 21, 1922 in Rowan County, NC to the late Roena Foard Beck and Lloyd O. Beck, he was a graduate of Spencer High School. He received a mechanical engineering degree from ICS. Mr. Beck completed a training program for part programming with Pratt and Whitney CNC Control Training School in West Hartford, Connecticut. He was retired from Norfolk-Southern Railroad after 43 years working as a project and development supervisor in the engineering department of Maintenance of Way.

Mr. Beck was a lifelong member of Mt. Tabor United Methodist Church. He was a former Sunday school superintendent. He was a 32 degree Mason with the Fulton Lodge, a member of the Shrine Club, and a past worthy patron of the Eastern Star.
