November 15, 1938 - August 15, 2015

Mr. Louie Ward Flynn, 76, of Salisbury, went to be with his Lord and Savior on August 15, 2015 at Novant Health Rowan Regional Medical Center.

Mr. Flynn was born on November 15, 1938; in Rock Hill, South Carolina, to the late Ida Crotts Flynn and William Lawrence Flynn. He was a U.S. Navy veteran and served on the USS Ticonderoga (CVA-14). He received his honorable discharge on October 20, 1961. He retired from Duke Power in 1994. Mr. Flynn was an active member of Salisbury First Church of the Nazarene, where he served on the board as a trustee.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his brother, Perry Flynn and sisters, Vera Stringer and Irene Jones.
