Mr. Malcolm Judson Ryan, 91, of Salisbury, NC passed away Sunday, March 27, 2011 at the Lutheran Home at Trinity Oaks.

Born September 29, 1919, in Syracuse, NY he was the son of the late Hazel LeFever and Judson Ryan.

Mr. Ryan was a graduate of Clarkson College of Technology in Massena, NY with a degree in chemical engineering. He served in the US Navy as a lieutenant from 1944-1961. He worked as a purchasing agent for ALCOA from 1948 to 1981. Mr. Ryan was a member of Sacred Heart Catholic Church. He was a member of Engineers' Society of Western Pennsylvania, National Association of Purchasing Managers, and a life member of Certified Purchasing Manager.
