Margaret Buckley Barton, 73, of Salisbury, passed away Wednesday, April 27, 2011 at her home after a lengthy illness.

Born January 16, 1938 in Brasher Falls, NY, she was the daughter of the late Daniel Leo Buckley and Anna Grace Coughlin Buckley.
