Mrs. Margaret "Jean" Tribble Hendrix, 94, of Spencer, NC passed away Sunday, May 8, 2016 at her home after a brief illness. She was the wife of Calvin L. Hendrix.

Jean was born December 30, 1921 in Halifax County, VA. She was a daughter of the late Lee Thomas Tribble and Maggie Guthrie Tribble.

She graduated from Altavista High School and Lynchburg Business College.

She was a member of Central United Methodist Church, Mamie Lynch Guild, Vail Bible Study Sunday School Class and was a Cub Scout Leader of Troop 349.

She worked briefly at North Carolina Finishing Company and Security Bank, but primarily had the privilege of being a full time homemaker and record keeper for family business.
