Margie Canupp Wetmore Payne, 89, passed away on Sunday, May 7, 2017 at her residence at Trinity Oaks, Salisbury, North Carolina where she had lived for about three years.

She was born Margie Lucille Canupp on December 13, 1927 to the late John Anderson Canupp and the late Bessie Belle Foster Canupp in Cooleemee and graduated from Cooleemee High School.
