Mark Anton Carolla, of Herndon, VA, 74, passed away on July 15, 2024. Lieutenant Commander, USNR, Mark Carolla, was born on July 5, 1950, in Sharon, CT, to Anthony Carolla and Mary Carolla. Originally from Pearl River, NY, he graduated from Middlebury College with a B.A. in History (specializing in German, Russian, and Medieval History) and earned a Master's in Foreign Affairs from the University of Virginia.

Mark's career spanned over 45 years, dedicated to the service of his country through his roles in the Army, Navy, and the Department of Defense. Mark was a devoted husband, a loving father, and a proud grandfather. He was a historian and an expert in rail, air, transportation, security, and international affairs. A lifelong learner, he was always reading or studying a new language. His talent for storytelling captivated everyone around him.

He is survived by his wife of 41 years, Leeann Carolla; his daughters, Angela Wheeler (Emmitte Wheeler) and Katherine Elam (Matt Elam); granddaughters, Emma Wheeler and Victoria Elam; and his brother, Robert Carolla (Stacy Collins).

A Funeral Mass will be held at St. Joseph's Church, 750 Peachtree St., Herndon, VA, on August 14, 2024, at 11:00 AM, with a Celebration of Life reception to follow. Inurnment with full Military Honors will take place at Arlington National Cemetery at a later date.
