



Mark Steven Meseroll

July 22, 1955 - November 17, 2018

Mr. Mark Steven Meseroll, 63, of Salisbury, NC, passed away unexpectedly on November 17, 2018 at his residence.

Born July 22, 1955 in Knoxville, TN he was the son of the late Mary Kirsch and Norman Everett Meseroll.

He was a graduate of Piscataway High School in Piscataway, NJ. Mark also graduated from Florida State University where he played football. After college, he went on to play in the NFL for the New Orleans Saints for 2 years. He then played for the Oakland Raiders until a career ending injury. He was a member of the National Football League Players Association. After his football career he developed and owned ProCast Metals for 30 years, a metal sales company alongside his son Steven. When his daughter, Katie was diagnosed with cancer he stopped working and never left her side.

Mr. Meseroll volunteered as a coach with his children's sports teams. He was heavily involved in planning and organizing the Brenner Children's Hospital Celebrity Golf Tournament for 25 years. Mark was a member of Sacred Heart Catholic Church.

Mr. Meseroll is preceded in death by his daughter, Katie Meseroll, September 8, 2016. Those left to cherish his memory are his wife, Jackie Livingston Meseroll, whom he married April 4th 1981; son, Steven Meseroll and wife Lauren along with their children, Sarah and John Everett Meseroll; brothers, Jeff Meseroll and wife Diane of Savannah, GA; Scott Meseroll and wife Mary Lou of Lecanto, FL; along with numerous nieces and nephews.

Visitation will be held from 10-11AM, Friday, November, 23, 2018 at Sacred Heart Catholic Church. Mass of Christian Burial will follow at 11AM Friday with Father John Eckert officiating. Burial will follow in the church cemetery.

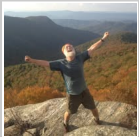
