Martha Elizabeth Barnhardt Arthur, 75, of Carolina Beach, NC formerly of Salisbury, NC passed away Friday, March 19, 2021 at her residence.

Born September 18, 1945 in Rowan County, she was the daughter of the late Manlus Crawford Barnhardt, Jr. and Frances Hinkle Barnhardt.
