



Mr Martin Cecil Kimmer

August 16, 1921 - July 16, 2016

Martin Cecil Kimmer, 94, of Salisbury passed away Saturday, July 16, 2016 at Novant Health Rowan Medical Center.

Born August 16, 1921 in Rowan County, he was the son of the late Edward David Kimmer and Sallie Martin Kimmer.

He was educated in the Spencer schools and graduated in 1940 from Spencer High School. Mr. Kimmer was a veteran of the Army Air Corps during World War II and served as a machinist with the 320th Depot Repair Squadron.

Mr. Kimmer was employed as a car inspector with Southern Railway with 37 years before retiring 1980.

He attended Calvary Lutheran Church. Mr. Kimmer loved woodworking and fishing and spent most of his life on High Rock Lake. He also enjoyed dancing in his later years, mostly to the music of the Big Band era. He had a long life and will be truly missed.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his wife, Charlotte Jackson Kimmer on October 15, 1989 and a son, Jerry Cecil Kimmer in 1985.

Those left to cherish his memory are his daughter, Joyce Clawson of Salisbury; sisters, Barbara Bowler of Hamlet and Doris Coates of Florida. Five grandchildren, ten great-grandchildren and 4 great great-grandchildren also survive.
