Mr. Marvin Lester Taylor, 66, of High Point, NC passed away Monday, February 21, 2011 at High Point Regional Medical Center.

Born February 8, 1945 in Alma, GA to Letha Black Taylor and Orren Taylor who passed away when he was young, and raised by Jack and Rena Hutto, Mr. Taylor graduated from Bacon County High School in Alma, GA. He received his Associate Degree from Gaston College in Gastonia, NC and a Bachelor Degree from NC A&T in Greensboro, NC.

Mr. Taylor was an Engineer for AT&T where he retired in 2004 after more than 20 years of work. He was a veteran of the US Air Force and served in Vietnam. He was a member of the Masonic Bulla Lodge in Burlington, NC.

Mr. Taylor was preceded in death by a son, Orren Taylor in September 1976.
