Mrs. Mary Jane Smiley Thompson departed to her heavenly home on February 3, 2024, surrounded by loved ones. Mrs. Thompson was born in Salisbury, NC in 1937, graduated from Boyden High School, and received her degree in Sociology from the University of NC in Greensboro in 1958. Shortly thereafter, she married Charles Jefferson Thompson (Jeff) and settled in Maryland to raise their family. As the children grew, Mrs. Thompson then entered the Elementary Education field and taught many grade levels throughout her career. Mr. and Mrs. Thompson retired from education and returned to their beloved hometown of Salisbury to enjoy their retirement years with extended family and many friends. In January 2023, they relocated to Midlothian, VA to be near loved ones.

Mary Jane had many interests such as knitting, crocheting, cross stitching, playing bridge and scrabble, sewing, and working puzzles. She was a lifelong member of the United Methodist Church and strongly involved with mission endeavors.
