Mary "Marie" Korzun Vogler, 83, of Salisbury passed away Saturday, June 27, 2015 at the Glenn A. Kiser Hospice House.

Born September 8, 1931 in Worcester, MA, she was the daughter of the late Anthony and Mary Nawrocki Korzun.

She married William Vogler in 1956 at All Saints Episcopal Church in Worcester, and was happily married for 37 years until Bill's sudden death in 1994. She mourned his loss for the remainder of her life.

Marie had a keen interest in history, a love of books and travel and was an accomplished photographer.

She and Bill lived in Shewsbury, MA for 25 years before moving to Manchester, VT. Marie moved to Salisbury, NC in 2006.

She was Executive Assistant to the President of Johnson Steel and Wire Co. of Worcester, worked for the design firm of Decorative Interiors and Laura's Interior Design in Manchester, VT.

Marie volunteered at Hildene South Vermont Art Center, Friends of the Library, member of the Garden Club and for ten years served on the Board of

Directors of the Vermont Association for the Blind and Visually Impaired.

In addition to her parents and husband, she was preceded in death by her sister, Stella Napierkowski of Beaufort, NC; brother, Arthur Korzun of Ojai, CA.

Those left to cherish her memory are her nephew, Albert Napierkowski and wife Judy of Florida, Richard Korzun and wife Esther of Vermont, Tony Korzun and wife of California, niece, Irene Norton and husband Jack of Salisbury, Linda Kocisak of California, Katie Korzun and husband Geoff of California and many great nieces and nephews she dearly loved.

Now Marie and Bill are together again forever.

The family will receive friends from 6-7:30 PM Wednesday (July 1) at the Summersett Funeral Home.
