Mrs. Mary Dell Newton Sloop, of Salisbury, NC passed away Wednesday, November 2, 2011 at Rowan Regional Medical Center after a period of declining health.

Born in Screven County, GA, she was the daughter of the late Benjamin Phillip Newton and Lizzie Dell McGee Newton. Mrs. Sloop was educated in the Screven County Schools, a graduate of Tift College in Forsyth, Georgia, and of the Howard School of Technology in Savannah, GA.
