Mavis Frick Wilson of Salisbury died Tuesday, June 8, 2010 at Rowan Regional Medical Center.

Born in Rowan County, she was the daughter of the late Paul Lewis Frick and Nannie Yost Frick. Educated in the Salisbury schools, she graduated from Boyden High School and Catawba College.

Mrs. Wilson was a school teacher in Claymont Special School District, Claymont, Delaware for 28 years before retiring.

She was a member of the First Baptist Church of Salisbury, once served on the Home Bound Committee, and was a member of national, state and local education associations in Delaware.
