



Rev. Melvin Clay Austin

December 29, 1932 - April 7, 2017

Rev. Melvin Clay Austin, 84 of Salisbury passed away Friday, April 7, 2017 at the Glenn A. Kiser Hospice House surrounded by family.

Born December 29, 1932 in Salisbury, he was the son of the late Joseph Calvin Austin and Lula Troutman Austin.

He was educated in the Salisbury schools and graduated from Boyden High School where he participated in all sports. Mr. Austin was a veteran of the US Army's 82nd Airborne.

Rev. Austin was a Minister and served at New Hope Baptist Church. He also owned and operated Mel's Upholstery.

He was a member of Safe Harbor Baptist Church, was a singer, songwriter and authored numerous books.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by a wife, Shirley Breeden Austin and his 5 brothers and sister.

Those left to cherish his memory are his daughters, Patti Austin Clifton (Curt Porter) of Greer, SC and Penny Austin Curtis (Johnny) of Salisbury; son, Michael Clayton Austin; the mother of his children, Edith Whitted of Taylors,
