Meredith Elaine Hylton, 41, of Lexington, NC passed away Tuesday, March 1, 2016 at Wake Forest Baptist Health.

Born May 4, 1974 in Salisbury, NC she was the daughter of Nancy Talley Hylton and Bill L. Hylton. Meredith was an honor graduate of Sheets Memorial Christian School in Lexington, NC. She earned her degree in elementary education from Liberty University, Lynchburg, VA and her masters of elementary education from High Point University, High Point, NC. Meredith taught at Sheets Memorial Christian School for seven years and taught at Churchland Elementary School in Churchland, NC for 12 years where she was awarded Teacher of Year for 2015-2016.

She attended Bethany Chapel in Salisbury, NC. She served on the summer mission trip with Word of Life to Australia and was a summer missionary for Child Evangelism Fellowship. She worked for a number of years as a counselor, assistant director, and cook at Mountain Top Youth Camp and coached basketball at Sheets Memorial.

Preceding her in death are her maternal grandparents, Clarence and Virginia Fleming Talley; and niece, Bethany Ann Hylton.


