Michael William LeBlanc, age 61, passed away March 25, 2026 at Atrium Health in Charlotte, North Carolina.

Michael served his country in the United States Army for 4 years, including a brief tour in the Gulf War. He got his bachelor's degree at Southeastern University in Lakeland, Florida. Established a successful business and family before moving to North Carolina in 2003. He loved golfing, spreading the gospel, and helping people.

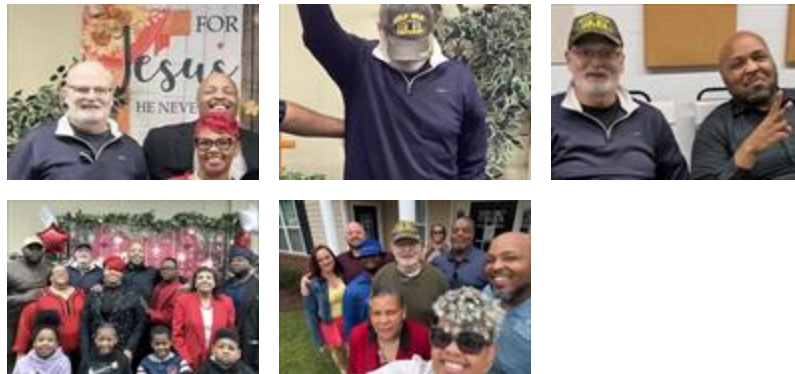
