With broken hearts, we sadly announce the passing of Michael “Mike” David Rescigno, 58, of Blythewood, SC, formerly of Salisbury on Monday, October 4, 2021 at his home.

Born March 18, 1963 in Rantoul, IL, he was the son of Melvia “Jean” Burleson Rescigno of Little River, SC, and the late Henry Rescigno.

Mike graduated from West Rowan High School, Class of 1981 and received his Bachelor and Master’s Degrees in Business Administration from Montreat College.
