



Milton Sides Ruble

June 5, 1919 - November 30, 2010

Mr. Milton Sides Ruble, 91, of Salisbury, NC passed away on Tuesday, November 30, 2010 at his residence.

Born June 5, 1919 in Salisbury, NC to the late Juanita Sides Ruble and William Milton Ruble, he was a graduate of Boyden High School, Class of 1938, where he played on the Football team. He served in the U.S. Army during WWII and the Army Reserve following the war. Mr. Ruble was employed with the Norfolk/Southern Railroad from 1937 until his retirement at 47 years. He was supervisor at Spencer Shops.

Mr. Ruble was a member of First United Methodist Church and the Friendship Sunday school class. He was also a member of the Hudson-Miller-Tatum VFW Post #3006 and the Rockwell Masonic Lodge. He volunteered with Meals on Wheels and was instrumental in the renovation of the 604 Steam Engine at the Spencer Shops.

Mr. Ruble is survived by his wife, Ruth Lloyd Ruble; two sons: William Milton Ruble and wife Shirley of Rockwell, NC and Dan L. Ruble and wife Manda of Rockwell, NC; daughter: Amy Allison and husband Gary of Rockwell, NC; six grandchildren and three great-grandchildren.
