



Miriam Horton Park

July 16, 1923 - January 25, 2013

Mrs. Miriam Horton Park, 89, of Salisbury, NC died Friday, January 25, 2013 at Rowan Regional Medical Center, after a brief illness. She had been in declining health for several years and was a resident at Trinity Oaks.

Born July 16, 1923, a Salisbury native, Mrs. Park was a daughter of the late J. Allen and Mary Lyerly Horton. She was a graduate of Boyden High School and Catawba College. She was married to the Rev. Karl M. Park, who preceded her in death in 2000. In Lutheran parishes in Leesville and Lancaster, SC; Murfreesboro, TN; and Salisbury, Albemarle, Hendersonville and Lincolnton, she taught Sunday school and was a musician and choir member. By profession, she was an educator.

Mrs. Park is survived by daughters, Mary Jane Park of St. Petersburg, FL; the Rev. Terry Park Hannon (John), Fairfax, VA; sons, Robert Park of Gastonia; Karl Park (Julie) of Lincolnton; three grandchildren; and three great-grandchildren.

Funeral services will be held at 11AM Monday, January 28, 2013 at St. John's Lutheran Church with Rev. Rhodes Wooley officiating. The family will receive friends in the church library following the service.
