Walter Odell Graham, 81 of China Grove died Monday, September 21, 2009 at Carolinas Medical Center, Northeast, in Concord.

Born October 21, 1927 in Rowan County, he was the son of the late Council Franklin and Emma Benson Graham. He was educated in the Rowan County schools and was a veteran US Coast Guard.

Mr. Graham played professional baseball for the Philadelphia Phillies and the Brooklyn Dodgers from 1945-1949. He was employed by the W.G. Hefner VA Medical Center for 30 years before retiring in 1988.

He was a member of the Second Presbyterian Church of Salisbury.

Mr. Graham was preceded in death by his brother, Tommy R. Graham and his sister, Thelma G. Barringer.

Survivors include his wife of 63 years, Ruth Jones Graham, whom he married December 25, 1945; son, Barry Dale Graham and wife Melody of Conover and granddaughter, Laura Ann Stone and husband Jason of Raleigh.

A memorial service will be conducted 11:00 AM Friday at Summersett Memorial Chapel with the Rev. Dr. Roger C. Mackey, minister of the Second Presbyterian Church officiating.

The family will speak to friends following the memorial service.

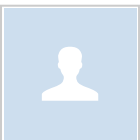
