Nancy Bradsher Gentry, 90, of Salisbury passed away Wednesday, June 19 at Novant Health Rowan Medical Center.

Mrs. Gentry was born September 3, 1922 in Person County the daughter of Nanny Hester Bradsher and Lewis A. Bradsher. She was a graduate of Person County Schools and Business College in Roxboro. Nancy retired from Selective Service System in 1973 where she worked for 27 years. She was a member of Second Presbyterian Church, The Circle #2, Harold B. Jarrett Auxiliary, VFW, volunteered for Meals on Wheels and she also served "Pinkie Hot Dogs" for 33 years at Rowan American Legion Baseball games.
