



## Narcidel Pennington Hoppe

July 4, 1925 - August 22, 2009

Narcidel Pennington Hoppe, 84, of Salisbury passed away Saturday August 22, 2009, at Rowan Regional Medical Center.

Mrs. Hoppe was born July 4, 1925, in Panhandle, TX, to the late Wilda Slagle Pennington and Foy Henry Pennington.

Narcidel graduated from Borger High School in 1942 and received a bachelors degree in chemistry from the University of Texas at Austin in 1949.

She was a devoted homemaker and taught English, mathematics, and chemistry prior to her marriage.

Narcidel was a member of First United Methodist Church in Salisbury, member of the United Methodist Women, a Sunday school teacher, Girl Scout leader, longtime volunteer for the American Bible Society, and also volunteered for Meals on Wheels.

Mrs. Hoppe is survived by her husband, John G. 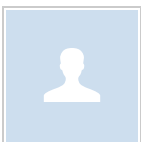
