Neal Alderman, 87, of Salisbury, NC passed away Thursday April 23, 2020 at Glenn A. Kiser Hospice House in Salisbury.

Born September 15, 1932 in Carroll County, Virginia, Neal was the son of the late Rupert Edward Alderman and Ella Kate Semmones Alderman.
