Nina Ruth Campbell Dickson, 84, of Salisbury, NC passed away Wednesday, May 2, 2018 at the Glenn A. Kiser Hospice House.

She was born October 1, 1933 in Bladen County, NC and was the daughter of the late Julian Jerome Campbell and Nellie Ruth Yarbrough Campbell.

She was educated in Columbus County schools and graduated from Clarkton High School, Class of 1951.

As a teen, she worked for Clarkton Trading Company. She served as an office worker at the First Baptist Church of Clarkton and worked as a bookkeeper for Prince Brothers Furniture Company. Mrs. Dickson was later an office supervisor with Sportee Corporation, office clerk for E. C. Clark Insurance, worked in the Bladen County School System as a school secretary and SIMS Operator for Booker T.
