Mr. Norvin Eugene Hillard, 84 of Faith passed away Sunday, April 17, 2016 at his home.

Born January 2, 1932 in Cooleemee, he was the son of the late Paul Revere Hillard and Frances Josey Hillard.

Mr. Hillard was placed at the Barium Springs Orphanage at the age of 5, where he was educated and graduated from high school. He was a veteran of the US Army during the Korean War.

He was a barber for 45 years, he worked in Landis and later owned and operated the Southgate Barber Shop for 40 years before retiring.

Mr. Hillard was a charter member of Tabernacle Baptist Church and the Faith American Legion Post #327.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his sisters, Marjoria Myrick, Lucille Hillard, Mary Eula Yountz and Cassie Mae Mills.

Those left to cherish his memory are his wife of 58 years, Carolyn Bame Hillard; son, Eric Eugene Hillard of Faith and grandson, Damien Price Hillard of Faith.
