Otis Ramsey Campbell, 87, of Salisbury died Saturday, August 21, 2010 at Rowan Regional Medical Center.

Born March 13, 1923 in Rowan County, he was the son of the late Luther Ramsey Campbell and Mattie Davis Campbell.

Mr. Campbell was educated in the Salisbury schools and Boyden High School. He was a veteran of the US Army's Tank Battalion during World War II and received the Purple Heart.

He owned and operated Campbell's Body and Salvage in the Franklin Community for 55 years.

He attended Franklin Presbyterian Church and the Jehovah Witness Church.
