Pasquale "Pat" Stellute, 66, of Salisbury, passed away Tuesday, June 18, 2019 at his home.

Born in Pittsburgh, PA, Pat was the son of the late Patsy and Rose Stellute. Pat received a B.S. degree in Chemical Engineering from Carnegie-Mellon University in Pittsburgh, PA and a M.S.A. in Public Administration from The George Washington University. He served four years active duty in the Army Corps of Engineers.

Pat began his 31 year career as a Technical Engineer at Fiber Industries. He progressed through various levels of management, retiring as Technical/Utilities Operations Manager.
