Pattie Bringle Steele Fink, age 87, of Salisbury, North Carolina went to her heavenly home on Thursday, January 5, 2017 at Autumn Care of Myrtle Grove Rehabilitation Center in Wilmington, NC.

Pattie was born in Salisbury, NC on May 15, 1929 to the late Lester Lee Bringle and Beulah Pierce Bringle. She was the second child out of four children raised in Salisbury.

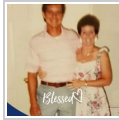
