Mr. Paul Harrison Adams, 89 of Salisbury passed away from natural causes on Saturday, February 19, 2011 at Rowan Regional Medical Center.

Born January 29, 1922 in White County, Georgia he was the son of the late Alfred Jess Adams and Jannie Allison Adams. Mr. Adams served in the U.S. Army as an enlisted Combat Infantryman where he served in Normandy, Northern France, Rhineland, Ardennes, and the European campaign where he was awarded the five Bronze stars one for meritorious conduct in action against the enemy. He was also wounded and received the Purple Heart.

Adams was a member of Oakdale Baptist Church in Spencer and retired from the VA Medical Center in Salisbury where he worked for over 25 years as a nurses aid.

He is survived by his wife, Anne Jacobs Adams and was married May 24, 1945. A son Darrell Adams of the home survives as well as one brother Willie Adams of Flowery Branch, Georgia.

The family will receive friends from 1-2 PM Monday at Summersett Funeral Home with a funeral service following at 2 PM in the Summersett Memorial Chapel. Rev. Richard A. Gross, Pastor of Oakdale Baptist Church is officiating. Burial will follow at Rowan Memorial Park Cemetery with military

honors.
