



Ransom Alexander Shuping

January 8, 1919 - March 23, 2011

Ransom Alexander Shuping, age 92, of Salisbury passed away Wednesday, March 23, 2011 at North Carolina State Veterans Home.

Mr. Shuping was born January 8, 1919 in Rowan County a son of the late Ross Lafayette and Jennie Alexander Shuping. He was a graduate of Cleveland High School, and drafted into the US Army in November 1941 and served 4 years in the 2nd Armored Division, under the leadership of Gen. George Patton and Gen. Omar Bradley. Ransom was employed by Carolina Tractor Company for 37 years. Thirty-five of those years he worked at the Asheville branch of Carolina Tractor Company. He was a member of Enon Baptist Church and was an avid gardener, loved planting and growing things.

In addition to his parents preceding him in death was a son David Ross Shuping; five brothers Lawrence, Ralph, Oscar, Marvin and Lonnie; sister Arlene Shuping Gray.

He is survived by his wife, Pauline Leab Shuping whom he married December 7, 1945; son Bruce Alexander Shuping (Kim) ; grandsons Jonathan and Jeremy Shuping and two step grandsons David and Adam Monteith.
