Reba Barber Krider, 73, passed away Wednesday, July 13, 2016 at Glenn A. Kiser Hospice House.

Born April 17, 1943 in Salisbury, she was the daughter of the late Grady Lee Barber and Phil Beck Barber.

She was educated in the North Rowan schools and graduated from North Rowan High School. A graduate of Appalachian State Teachers College, she received her Master's Degree from Appalachian and the University of North Carolina at Charlotte.

Reba was a teacher in Kentucky, Texas and then at North Rowan High School where she taught English and served as Year Book Editor. She was a radio personality on WSTP/WRDX Radio for many years and also taught at Rowan Cabarrus Community College.

She was a life-long member of Trading Ford Baptist Church and attended Second Presbyterian Church where she sang in the Choir. She enjoyed and attended American Legion Baseball and was a supporter of all North Rowan High School sports and Duke University Basketball.
