Rev. Don Dale Srail, 69, of Salisbury passed away Tuesday, Oct. 23, 2012 at Rowan Regional Medical Center. Don was also known by “the man with Zeke,” his seeing eye dog.

Born June 17, 1943 in Chicago, IL, he was the son of the late Milton and Marie Schroeder Srail.

Mr. Srail was educated in the Chicago schools and received his BA degree from Calvary Bible College, Kansas City, MO. He was a veteran of the US Army.

He was a church planter for the Northwest Independent Church Extension (N.I.C.E.) serving in Montana, and had served as pastor of Midlothian Bible Church, Midlothian, IL. In Salisbury, he was a member of Maranatha Bible Church. He was an active member of in the Blind Veterans Association and the Rowan Ramblers.

Those left to cherish his memory are his children, Joshua Srail of Norwood, Ruth Srail and Elizabeth Srail of Charlotte; grandson, Thomas John Waters of Charlotte; sister, Judy McCormack of Oakbrook, IL; and brother, Mitch Srail and wife Lori of Johns Creek, GA.
