Rev. William Taylor Church, 85 of Cleveland died Tuesday, June 1, 2010 at Gordon Hospice House, Statesville.

Born March 1, 1925 in Virginia, he was the son of the late George Washington and Martha Smith Church.

Mr. Church operated a lawn mower shop where he did small engine repair, was employed for a frame shop and formerly was employed for Angel Poultry in Mocksville.

He was a member of Community Baptist Church, Cooleemee where he occasionally conducted the worship service and later served as Assistant Minister of Faith of Christ Tabernacle.
