Dr. Richard Dorn Jordan, 79, of Salisbury passed away Thursday, October 29, 2015, at the Glenn A. Kiser Hospice House.

Born March 14, 1936 in Anderson, SC, he was the son of the late Rev. Howard Roy Jordan and Elizabeth Crouse Jordan.

Dr. Jordan graduated from Albemarle High School. He then attended Davidson College, where he was a member of Kappa Sigma Fraternity. Afterward he attended the University of North Carolina-Chapel Hill School of Medicine. He completed his Radiology Degree at Duke University, and served his internship at the University Hospital in Augusta, GA

He was a veteran of the US Air Force stationed in Tampa, FL.

Dr. Jordan served as Chief of Staff at Rowan Medical Center, Chairman of the Department of Radiology and was associated with Piedmont Radiological Associates of Salisbury before retiring in 1991.

Dr. Jordan was an active member of the First United Methodist Church.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his brother, Dr. Roderick Jordan of Kernersville.

Those left to cherish his memory are his wife of 57 years, Bettie Gantt Jordan; daughters, Elizabeth Crouse Jordan of Salisbury and Mary Dorn Jordan Riggsbee of Mooresville; grandchildren, Elizabeth Dorn Riggsbee and Mary Virginia Riggsbee.
