Richard Wiley "Dickey" Menius, Jr., 77, of Salisbury, went to be with the Lord Monday, October 11, 2021 at Novant Health Rowan Medical Center.

Born August 5, 1944 in Onslow County, NC, he was the son of the late Margaret Sisk Menius and Richard Wiley Menius, Sr. He was a 1962 graduate of South Rowan High School. He was manager at A&P in China Grove and worked as an insurance agent for Federated Mutual Insurance Company until retirement in 1991. Following retirement, he did carpentry and automotive work.

He was a member of Grace United Methodist Church. He was a volunteer for Rowan Helping Ministries and was active in mission work. He enjoyed traveling, fishing, spending time with his family and the lake life.

In addition to his parents he was preceded in death by his wife, Sandra Bame Menius on December 25, 2011. They were married July 14, 1962.

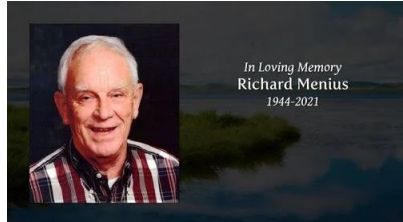
