Rinaldo Alfred Bernardi, 91 of Spencer died Tuesday, June 02, 2009 at the VA Medical Center, Oteen.

Born December 31, 1917 in Boston, MA, he was the son of the late Dina and Edith Salotti Bernardi. He was educated at Boston Latin High School and Boston Commerce High School, Boston, MA and Balboa Junior College, Panama.
