Mr. Robert "Bob" Taylor Shinn, Sr., 72, of Mount Ulla, NC passed away Monday, January 28, 2019 at Glenn A Kiser Hospice House. He passed away 1 month after being diagnosed with brain cancer.

Born May 27th, 1946 in Salisbury, NC he was the son of the late Ruby Miller Shinn and Horace Taylor Shinn.

He was a 1964 graduate of West Rowan High School, a graduate of Mitchell Community College and Appalachian State University with a bachelor degree in History.

Mr. Shinn was a beloved father, husband and friend and founder of the family business, The Feed Bucket in Mooresville NC, approximately 30 years ago. He grew up farming the family farm in Mount Ulla with his late father Horace Shinn.

After graduating from Appalachian, he taught at West Rowan Junior High School. He also worked at Belk for many years and owned several other businesses such as convenience stores throughout his life.
