



## Robert "Bob" Hugh Flournoy

March 12, 1941 - April 15, 2016

Robert "Bob" Hugh Flournoy, 75, died Friday, April 15, 2016, from complications of pneumonia and Multiple Myeloma at the Levine and Dickson Hospice House in Charlotte, NC.

Born March 12, 1941, in Shreveport, Louisiana, Bob was the son of the late Hugh Harrell Flournoy and Evelyn Hays Flournoy. He graduated from Fair Park High School, Shreveport, LA in 1959; Louisiana Polytechnic Institute in Ruston, LA with a Bachelor of Arts degree in 1963; and Louisiana State University in Baton Rouge, LA with a Master's degree in Social Work in 1970.

Bob worked as a psychiatric social worker at the VA Medical Center in Salisbury, NC for 27 years, and mentored many graduate-level social work students during his time there. He loved spending time with his family and friends, especially when he was relaxing with them at Lake Tillery. They loved him dearly and will miss his wonderful warmth, wisdom, and humor.

Bob was preceded in death by his parents and his wife of 38 years, Elizabeth "Betty" Colbert Flournoy. He is survived by his partner of eight years, Christine Boone; daughter Rebecca Flournoy Mardesich, her husband Andrew, and their son Max; Christine's children Elizabeth, Aaron, Alan, Bill and Richard Boone, and their children Oliver, Ana, Jessa, Liam, and Colin; brother Keith Flournoy and his wife Sherry; nieces Sharlette Hale and Geren Crenshaw and

their children Dakota, Jayce, Kaleb, and Raelin; brother-in-law Bill Colbert and his wife Pat; and niece and nephew Malissa DeBosier and Christopher Colbert and their children Zoey, Macy, Ethan, and Sarah.
