Mr. Robert "Lester" Hall of Salisbury, passed away Wednesday, September 21, 2016, at Novant Health Forsyth Medical Center.

Born August 18, 1932 in Calhoun Falls, SC, he was the son of the late Zimriah Asbury Hall and Cornelia Cann Hall.

Mr. Hall was a graduate of Ninety Six High School, Ninety Six, S.C. He served in the Air Force for four years, with a rank of Staff Sergeant. He was a 1958 graduate of Clemson University, majoring in Ceramic Engineering. His working years were mainly in the brick industry, except for four years in Nuclear Energy at the Savannah River Plant. His last place of employment was as a consultant for Statesville Brick Company, his favorite brickyard.

Lester was active in First Baptist Church of Salisbury, especially in the Summa Pretenda Sunday School Class. He enjoyed reading, square dancing, outings with the Hens and Roosters, fossil hunting, golf, and collecting golf balls. His love and concern for his family was a high priority in his life.

He was preceded in death by his son, Robert Lester Hall, Jr.
