Mr. Robert “Bob” L. Chandler, Jr. 89, of Terrell and formerly of Salisbury, NC passed away on Monday, June 28, 2010 at Lake Norman Regional Medical Center.

Born August 8, 1920 in Salisbury, NC to the late Zalia Culp Chandler and Robert L. Chandler, Sr. he was a graduate of Boyden High School and attended Catawba College. He served in the US Navy Seabees during WWII. Mr. Chandler retired as President of Home Oil & Coal and Home Concrete & Supply Company.
