



## Robert Lincoln Barringer

March 12, 1921 - November 27, 2012

Robert Lincoln Barringer, 91, of Salisbury passed away at Autumn Care of Salisbury Tuesday, November 27, 2012 after a brief illness.

Born March 12, 1921 in Rowan County, NC he was the son of the late David Barringer and Laura Agner Barringer. He was educated in the Rowan County schools where he graduated high school. Mr. Barringer served in the US Navy serving during WW II. After service he went to work at Cannon Mills plant #7 and became a supervisor in the weave room.
