Robert Dennis Sims, age 69, of Salisbury passed away Monday, July 22, 2019 at Novant Health Presbyterian Medical Center, Charlotte, NC.

Dennis was born July 5, 1950 in Lancaster, SC. Preceded in death by his father, Noah Thomas Sims, mother Harriet Robinson Sims and brother Randy Sims of Lancaster, SC. He graduated from Lancaster High School, Lancaster, SC and attended Charlotte Business College. He served in the Reserve of the Army National Guard of S.C. He was self-employed (RDS Services) as an Independent Claims Adjuster doing work for VFIS of York, PA and NC Grange Mutual of Greensboro, NC. He was going to retire on July 31, 2019.

Dennis was a faithful member of Milford Hills Baptist Church. He has served as a Deacon, member of the Pastoral search committee, chairman of the building and grounds committee, Baptismal committee and member of the personnel committee.

Dennis was a Master Mason for 47 years. He was a member of Andrew Jackson Lodge #576, serving as Master of the Lodge in 1990. He received the L.C. Lake, Jr. Memorial Award in 1997 and was Mason of the Year in 1995. Serving as Lodge Secretary from 1995 to present, Secretary of Distinction in 2014, Secretary and Treasurer of Lodge Trustees. He served on various Lodge and Grand Lodge committees. Treasurer of Rowan County Masonic Scholarship Committee/Board. District Deputy Grand Master of the 28th Masonic District 2002 to 2004. He was a York Rite Mason and received the York Rite Mason of the Year Award in 1993, Oasis Shriner and member of Rowan County Shrine Club. Dennis was one of "The Four D's".

Dennis was an avid fan of American Legion Baseball of Rowan County and had a reserved "Rocking Chair" at the World Series in Shelby, NC. He loved Catawba College football and baseball. He enjoyed the old NASCAR series.

Those left to cherish his memory are his wife of 49 years, Dorothy Howie Sims whom he married April 5, 1970. Sister Laura Taylor (Jeremy) of Lancaster, SC and numerous nieces and nephews.
