Robert D. Weast, 92, of Mt. Ulla, NC, passed away December 29, 2024 at Novant Health Rowan Medical Center.

Born August 21, 1932 in Bostic, NC, he was the son of the late Frank Chalmers and Annie Pauline Weast. A 1950 graduate of Mt. Ulla High School, he attended Appalachian State University for one year before entering the United States Army and served as the tank division radio commander at Fort Bragg. Following his discharge from the Army, he came back to help run the family dairy farm with his father. He continued to run the farm with his son until they sold it in 2005, he then delivered auto parts for several years.

Bob was a member of Thyatira Presbyterian Church.

In addition to his parents, he was preceded in death by his wife, Gerry Weast; brother, Albert Weast; sister, Frances McKinney and twin sister, Jean W. Nolley.
