



## Rosamond Bayne Wetmore

November 1, 1914 - June 25, 2012

Rosamond Bayne Wetmore, 97, of Salisbury passed away Monday, June 25, 2012 at home in Trinity Oaks.

Rosamond was born November 1, 1914 in Middlesboro, KY to the late Almeda Mason Bayne and Herbert Bayne.

She went to Middlesboro public Schools. After attending Lincoln Memorial University at Harrogate, TN for two years she transferred to Earlham College in Richmond, IN where she graduated in 1936 as Valedictorian; she earned a graduate degree in Library Science from Columbia University and a Masters of Arts in History from Ball State University.

She was employed as a reference librarian at Earlham College Library, a school librarian at Lloyd High School, Erlanger, KY, and at Beechwood School, Ft. Mitchell, KY. In 1946 she joined the faculty at Ball State University, Muncie, IN from which she retired as Professor of Library and Information Science in 1980.

She married Thomas Hall Wetmore July 5, 1941.

She was the author of "A Guide to the Organization of Library Materials" and was listed in "Who's who of American Women."

Mrs. Wetmore was a member of the Daughters of American Colonists and St. Luke's Episcopal Church.

She was preceded in death by her husband Dr. Thomas H. Wetmore in 2005.

Those left to cherish her memory are two sons Stephen Bayne Wetmore of Ottawa, IL, Dr. Allyn Christopher Wetmore and wife Yen of South Hill, VA, five grandchildren Dr. Gail Kent and Husband Ben, Dr. Mimi Murphy and husband Dr. Brian, Jill Wetmore, Greg Sorel, Kwang Marler, four Great-grandchildren, and numerous nieces and nephews.

A memorial service will be held 2 PM Saturday (June 30) at the Chapel of Trinity Oaks Retirement Community with the Rev. Gene Bruce officiating. Burial will be in Maplawn Cemetery, Pennville, IN at a later date.
