Mr. Roy Odell Bogle, 94, of Salisbury, passed away Tuesday, June 23, 2009 at Rowan Regional Medical Center.

Born in Rowan County on October 2, 1914, he was the son of the late Harvey Wakefield Bogle, and Harriett Elizabeth (Betty) Albright.

Mr. Bogle worked in Saw Mill work, at Cannon Mills and retired from Southern Railroad as Carman after 31 years of service. He did a lot of farm work for himself and others.
