



Ruby Mae Rummage Beeker

August 18, 1932 - February 20, 2010

Mrs. Ruby Mae Rummage Beeker, 77, of Salisbury, passed away Saturday, February 20, 2010 at Presbyterian Hospital in Charlotte.

Born August 18, 1932 in Davie County, she was the daughter of the late Boone Reece Rummage, and Mildred Boger Rummage. She graduated from Statesville City Schools and attended Mitchell Community College.

Mrs. Beeker was employed with Security Bank for 18 years and also worked as a bookkeeper at Spencer Rest Home. In her latter years, she worked at The Little Choo-Choo Shop in Spencer.

She was a member of Milford Hills United Methodist Church and the Women of the Word Sunday School Class.

Mrs. Beeker was involved in the Historic Salisbury Foundation, the Tour Guild, the Old North Salisbury Preservation Association, where she was one of the early tour guides at the Grimes Mill and the Rowan County Literacy Council.
