



## Rudolph Paul Boksleitner

April 29, 1938 - August 13, 2022

Rudolph “Rudy” Paul Boksleitner, 84, of Salisbury, NC died on Saturday, August 13, 2022 at Novant Rowan Medical Center.

Born April 29, 1938 in Camden, NJ, he was the son of the late Paul Boksleitner and Anna Ferbach Boksleitner.

Mr. Boksleitner is a graduate of Drexel University and the University of Cincinnati, earning a Master’s degree in both Science and Community Planning. He worked with various government centers in Cincinnati, Charlottesville, and the Research Triangle Park, NC.
